

Josyan Madi Skaff is presently the head of the Psychiatry Department at the Lebanese Hospital – Geitawi, in Beirut, Lebanon.

She is the co-founder of the Lebanese Psychiatric Society, and in 2004 became the 1<sup>st</sup> and only woman president of the Society. In 2005 she organized the 1st Women's Mental Health Conference to be held in the Middle-East.
